

Special features (1/4)

- Cloud-based tools, no costs and a variety of formatting tools and special effects (e.g. Google slides)
- Visually move featured images (e.g. Apple's Keynote)
- Non-linear presentations for less formal, conversational presentations (e.g. Prezi)
- Publish to the web (e.g. Zoho Show)
- Focus on interactivity to create visual media (e.g. Genial.ly)

- Analytic tools to know the details about how the presentation was seen (e.g. FlowVela)
- Build a slide library to share with the team (e.g. CustomShow)
- See who is viewing the presentation and how engaged they are (e.g. Slidebean)
- Use thousands of images licensed under Creative Commons (e.g. Haiku Deck)
- Include pop-ups and other types of visual content (e.g. Visme)

Special features (2/4)

- Suggest ways to visualize the ideas using AI (e.g. Beautiful.ai)
- Include 3D models (e.g. Ludus or Emaze)
- Integration with online services like Vimeo (e.g. Slides)
- Tools to add shapes (e.g. Adobe InDesign)
- HTML5 presentations (e.g. Focusky)
- Create animated stories for presentations, voiceovers, integrate with animated characters (Powtoon)

- Export to SlideShare (e.g. 280 Slides)
- Integrate content from sites like Flickr or Youtube (e.g. SlideRocket)
- Easy to customize the templates (e.g. Slides or Canva)
- No font limitation (e.g. Libre Office Impress)
- Social media image editor (e.g. Visme)
- Customizable content blocks (e.g. Slidebean)

Special features (3/4)

- Create animated presentations in video format (e.g. GoAnimate or Adobe Spark)
- Built-in broadcasting tools to stream presentations (e.g. Zoho Show)
- Turn notes into presentations (e.g. Microsoft Sway)
- Turn PDFs, videos, images, text outline into a presentation (e.g. Swipe)
- Use text commands to arrange items (e.g. Deckset)

- Email presentation to the list of contacts and track the results (e.g. Kineticast)
- Dedicated to tutorials with screenshots, explanations boxes, buttons, titles (e.g. Wink)
- Presentations for customer support with videos of on-screen activities (e.g. Camtasia or Camstudio)
- Weave together stories with style and personality from flickr photos, RSS feeds, tweets, Vimeo videos (e.g. Projeqt)

Special features (4/4)

- Create animated figures for presentation and add animated avatars and comic effects for other presentation tools (e.g. Reallusion)
- In-built-analytics for understanding user insights (e.g. Docketzoom)
- Interactive publications that are personalized (e.g. Instant Magazine)
- Tools to manage live stream, record, and share videos across your organization (e.g. Panopto)

- Combine materials from many sources like prezi, ppts, pdf,s xls, video, images, web pages (e.g. SlideDog)
- Leave comments to other users to review (e.g. WPS Presentation)
- Sharing and tracking views and annotations on slides (e.g. Slideshark)
- For presentations in conference system to organize them (e.g. Presaria)
- Quizzing (e.g. Articulate Presenter)
