Exercises

1. Display to standard output the message "Hello word!"

2. Display to standard output all parameters passed on command line of a java program.

3. Calculate the biggest common divisor of two numbers a and b that are passed like arguments on command line.

4. Simulate the dice throwing action, for a n numbers of times (n is passed like argument on command line) using the random number generator from: a) Math class b) Random class

5. Calculate *n*! for a number *n* that is passed like argument on command line. The factorial will be calculated only for numbers n that satisfies the following condition $0 \le n \le 12$.

6. Write a program that verifies if a number passed like command line argument is a palindrome.

7. Write a program that displays at standard output the first *n* terms of Fibonacci sequence: $a_0 = a_1 = 1$, $a_n = a_{n-1} + a_{n-2}$. The number n is passed like argument on command line.

8. Write a program that checks if a number n random generated, with the property that n
